

The main color is Ecru which represents the mountains and water. With adding a touch of Purple, Silver and gold which represents the reflection of the sunset on the water.









































Concept.

the feathers were used to break the line between both sides.




In this collection I explored a new method of work which required fine-detailed craftsmenship and different fabrics.



In this collection I wanted to show my inspiration of strong modern woman by incoraptiong different volumes and fabrics.


The fabrics used are used Organza, Satin, chiffon, Crepe and Lace.
